Can I apply? Yes, if...

You receive one of the following benefits:

- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part 6 of the Immigration and Asylum Act
- Guaranteed element of State Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit (but not Working Tax Credit) and have an annual income not over £16,190
- Working Tax Credit 4-week run on (the payment you get when you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit)

And from September 2014, you can also apply if you receive

- Working Tax Credits and earn no more than £16,190 a year

You care for a child:

- who is looked after by the local authority
- who has left care through adoption, residence order or special guardianship

Your child:

- has a current statement of special educational needs or an Education, Health and Care plan;
- is in receipt of the Disability Living Allowance.

When can my child start?

It's a good idea to apply early, at least four weeks before your child can start. The date your child can start will depend on when your child is two.

Birthday	Start date
1 January to 31 March	April
1 April to 31 August	September
1 September to 31 December	January
